Spiritual Needs: Bible verses, stories, and songs will present the Gospel of Christ. Connection with a local church body where each child can spiritually mature is the ultimate goal.

Scheduled dates for Camp Hope 2010

Spring Break (March 15-19)

- Take sack lunches everyday at noon to apartment complexes.
- On 2 days, stay for an hour of activities with the kids.

Summer (mid June- early August)

- Take sack lunches everyday to several locations around Parker County.
- Provide 1 ½ hours of activities 3 days a week.
- Camps at apartment complexes will begin at noon. Areas without an air conditioned building will begin at 10 am.
